Financing the Quality Infrastructure within the AfCFTA	Resolution 2: The meeting noted the highlights on the funding of the Quality Infrastructure activities and the commitments by PTB to continue the funding of Quality Infrastructure activities aiming to support the AfCFTA TBT/SPS Annexes' implementation.
	Resolution 2.1: PAQI Institutions and RECs agreed to continue exploring ways ensuring their financial Sustainability in order to fund their QI programmes and Capacity Building without relying always on the donor funding.
Update on AUC developments on the implementation of AfCFTA	Resolution 3: The meeting took note of the update provided by the AUC representative including the on-going ratification of the AfCFTA Agreement by member States and the report on the conclusions of the AfCFTA TBT Annexe 6.
PAN-AFRI	Resolution 3.1: The meeting emphasised the need for a more strategic relationship between PAQI Institutions and AUC (DTI) to ensure effective implementation of the Quality Infrastructure programmes.
	Resolution 3.2: The meeting urged PAQI to submit a programme of work to the AU Ministerial Meeting in October 2018 indicating activities for implementation and the strategies for cooperation with AUC.
Overview of the AfCFTA Annex 6 TBT Issues	Resolution 4: The meeting took note of the highlights of Annex 6 of the AfCFTA as it relates to the implementation of Quality Infrastructure services and PAQI institutions agreed to work closely with RECs for its implementation.
	Resolution 4.3 In collaboration with AUC, UNECA and any other partner, RECs and PAQI Institutions agreed to develop a strategy for cooperation in the implementation of their Quality Infrastructure Programmes for implementation of Annexe 6 (TBT) of the AfCFTA.

UNECA presentation on National AfCFTA Strategies to effectively implement the Agreement	Resolution 5.1: The meeting took note of the presentation by UNECA on upcoming technical cooperation projects to support AU Member States to develop the AfCFTA National Strategies. Resolution 5.3: PAQI institutions and RECs agreed to inform their members of the National AfCFTA Committees being formed which are mandated to oversee the implementation of AfCFTA at national level for their active participation.
	Resolution 5.4: The PAQI Forum meeting agreed to mobilise African Countries for universal membership of both International organisations (IEC, ISO, ILAC, WTO) and Continental organisations (AFRAC, AFRIMETS, AFSEC and ARSO) in line with the 2014 AU CAMoT resolution, which also encouraged that QI Awareness creation be widely undertaken.

Resolution 7: The meeting agreed that cooperation between PAQI and RECs should be strengthened and this should include
PAN-AF	collaboration in the implementation of the Cassava Value Chain project. Resolution 8: The meeting called upon all the RECS to advise their Member States to consider developing National Quality Policies as appropriate.
Presentation of RECs activities with regard to QI and their defined role	Resolution 9: The meeting noted with appreciation the updates of COMESA and ECOWAS activities and resolved to circulate the EAC presentation which was sent to PAQI Secretariat.
in the AfCFTA Implementation	Resolution 10: The meeting encouraged the PAQI institutions to promote synergy with the Regulatory bodies in Africa to enhance smooth implementation of Quality Infrastructure services and Technical Regulations for the implementation of the AfCFTA.
	Resolution 14: PAQI pillars and RECs are urged to continue with awareness creation among their members on the need for adopting and implementing harmonised continental standards and conformity assessment regimes, and called upon ARSO and AFSEC to avail harmonised standards to all African countries, including non-member countries for a certain period of time.
	Resolution 15: Highlighted the importance of Quality Award and resolved that the PAQI Secretariat to conduct a feasibility study on modalities of its implementation.
